In order to block land arrangements, a non-refundable deposit of USD \$100.00 must be received by Friday, May 17, 2019, together with a signed registration form. The rate is based on 10 people signing up. If the group falls below 10 people, the trip will be booked under Free Independent Traveller - FIT. Payments can be made on your trip. Final payment is due by June 29, 2020.

ADDITIONAL DEPOSIT:

At times, additional deposits may be required for your arrangements and at times this information may be advised after initial quote or confirmation. If applicable, we will advise you as soon as we are made aware of this by the supplier.

G'Day and welcome to Australia! On arrival in Sydney this morning, you will be met by our local representative and transferred to your hotel to check in (Note: hotel rooms may not be ready for check in until after 2pm). The rest of the day is at leisure.

Accommodation: Radisson Blu Plaza Hotel Sydney or similar for 3 Nights

DAY 4 / OCT 11, 2020 SYDNEY CITY SIGHTS

(B, L)

After breakfast, meet your guide and depart by private coach for a **Sydney City Tour**. We drive through the historic 'Rocks' area where Australia was first founded with its maze of terrace houses, restored warehouses, pubs and restaurants. Drive under the famous 'coat hanger', the Sydney Harbour Bridge and view Sydney's famous architectural masterpiece, the Sydney Opera House.

We continue through the commercial area of the city passing the historical buildings of Macquarie Street – Parliament House, The Mint and Hyde Park Barracks. Alight at Mrs Macquarie's Chair for breath-taking views of the city and harbour. Proceed through cosmopolitan Kings Cross and exclusive garden suburbs to the Gap on the ocean headland at Watsons Bay. Return to the city via famous Bondi Beach and Paddington, a Victorian suburb of restored terrace houses richly decorated with cast-iron lace.

****Tour highlights in above itinerary maybe in different order due to traffic conditions*



The tour concludes at Circular Quay where the guide will walk with you to Captain Cook's office at Jetty 6 and check-in for your Harbour Cruise. Board **Captain Cook Cruises** to enjoy a Seafood Buffet Lunch.

The Sydney Harbour which most travel experts agree is one of the most scenic harbours in the world. You will see spectacular views of Sydney Harbour Bridge, Circular Quay, The Rocks, Opera House, Fort Denison, Point Piper, Watson's Bay. See Sydney's foreshore parkland and many stately homes. Enjoy the live commentary while you feast on a smorgasbord of fine Australian cuisine. The buffet features the finest selection of Australian prime meats, fresh seafood, roast

vegetables and salads, coffee and tea. Dine indoors and then if you like you can take in the scenery from the viewing deck.

The cruise returns to Circular Quay at 2:20pm, then the guide will walk with you to **Opera House** and check-in for the private tour. Please check in at the Cloak Room Desk located on the Lower Concourse. Your tour then departs from the Lower Concourse located downstairs outside the Sydney Opera House Shop. You are guided into theatres, given a fascinating account of the history and architecture of the House and introduced to the magic of performance. With its white, sculptural 'shells' rising from the harbour foreshore at Bennelong Point, the Opera House is Sydney's most recognisable building and, officially, one of the seven wonders of the 20th century. Joern Utzon, the Danish architect who designed the Opera House, ascribed the inspiration for his masterpiece to the sails of yachts on the harbour. As the Opera House is first and foremost a performing arts centre, some areas may be restricted for viewing due to rehearsals and performances.

After the tour, you can spend more leisure time at the Circular Quay and make your way back to the hotel (within walking distance from Circular Quay).

DAY 5 / OCT 12, 2020 SYDNEY FULL DAY BLUE MOUNTAINS TOUR (B, L)

After a full breakfast this morning, meet with your local guide and depart on a full day Blue Mountains Tour. Please note that Local guide has not been included and a professional coach driver will provide the commentary instead.

We visit **Featherdale Wildlife Park** for a memorable and unique experience in a natural and well established bush setting. Featherdale has one of Australia's largest private collections of Australian animals, and you can see Koalas, kangaroos and wallabies, wombats, fairy penguins and Australian reptiles.



We Follow the trail of Australia's early explorers as the coach ascends into the **Blue Mountains National Park**, and travel through the historic townships of Blaxland, Springwood, Lawson and Wentworth Falls and view the National Trust township of Leura. Leura is a little town of cafes, craft shops, art galleries, tea houses and quaint boutiques. It is situated at the edge of the Blue Mountain National Park and has magnificent views of Mt Solitary. Continue along Cliff Drive to Echo Point to view the world famous "Three Sisters". Perched on the edge of the escarpment, Echo Point precinct provides panoramic views of the southern Blue Mountains, Kanangra-Boyd Wilderness and the iconic Three Sisters rock formation from a variety of lookouts.



Lunch today is included at a Blue Mountains local restaurant, where you enjoy a 2 course meal. After lunch, our tour continues with **Scenic World**, located in the World Heritage-listed Blue Mountains, which is renowned for providing the ultimate Blue Mountains Adventure, from native birds and fresh air, to breathtaking views of the World Heritage-listed region including the Three Sisters, Katoomba Falls & Jamison Valley.

On your visit, enjoy a ride on the **scenic railway**, one of the world's steepest incline railways, descending 415 metres down the escarpment at a maximum grade of 52 degrees. This thrilling and unique ride passes through an 80-metre tunnel down to sunlit tree clad valley. You can walk along a 390-metre boardwalk and pass through a temperate rainforest and also entrances to the old coalmines, where you can view an audiovisual display. The boardwalk connects to the bottom platform of the Scenic Cableway, the world's steepest aerial cable car. The Scenic Cableway will whisk you back up to the top of the valley. After the tour, we make your way back to Sydney and your hotel.

Tour highlights in above itinerary may run in different order due to traffic conditions

DAY 6 / OCT 13, 2020 FLY SYDNEY TO AYERS ROCK**(B)**

After the breakfast and check out the hotel and you will be collected from your hotel for private coach transfer to the airport to take your flight to Ayers Rock (cost of flight NOT included).

Upon your arrival, you will be transferred by private coach to your hotel for checking in. Free at your leisure until this afternoon we experience the harsh Outback on a visit to the massive series of conglomerate domes known as Kata Tjuta (formally The Olgas) in the Aboriginal language as “**Kata Tjuta**” translated as “many heads”. Each of the 36 domes has a story in mythology and are of significance to the Aboriginal Dreamtime legends. Enjoy a walk to **Olga Gorge** and explore the unusually shaped formations.

We continue to take a **Sunset Tour** to the sunset viewing strip to see the Rock at its most dramatic. Here you will have the opportunity to photograph the striking colour changes that can take place in this majestic part of Australia. When conditions are right, the Rock glows crimson for a few short minutes as the sun sets. In the end of the tour we transfer to your hotel.

DAY 7 / OCT 14, 2020**AYERS ROCK****(B)**

For the early risers, depart from your hotel 75 minutes prior to sunrise by private coach for the **Ayers Rock Sunrise and Base Tour**. We travel to the sunrise viewing area of Uluru (Ayers Rock) and watch the first sunlight of the day creep across the desert plains.

We re-join the coach for the Base Tour of Uluru (Ayers Rock). Begin with a drive around the base of Uluru. Your driver will point out a number of interesting features of the monolith, then take you on a walking tour of **Mutitjulu Waterhole** where you can view Aboriginal rock art. If time permits, you may visit the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre. The tour concludes at your hotel and the rest of the day and evening at leisure.

OPTIONAL A: Sound of Silence Dinner

Your Sounds of Silence experience begins with enjoying canapés and sparkling wine while the sun sets over Uluru. As darkness falls, join your table for an unforgettable bush tucker inspired dining experience, cultural dance and didgeridoo performances and a star talk under the outback sky.

Inclusions: Canapés, Beer, wine and non-alcoholic drinks, Tea and coffee, Buffet BBQ (vegetarian options available with prior notice) Scrumptious desserts Entertainment Star talk and stargazing.

OPTIONAL B: Camel Ride Tour

Meander for one hour through the rich red sand dunes on your friendly camel to watch the awe-inspiring backdrop of Uluru and Kata Tjuta change colour as the sun sets. Our skilled cameleers describe the flora and fauna of the outback landscape surrounding you on your ride. Return to the farm at twilight to enjoy a selection of alcoholic beverages and outback bush foods including our freshly baked beer bread damper

Inclusions: 1 Hour Camel Ride Drinks, Snacks & Camel Display.

The cruise returns to Fleet terminal approximately at 5:00pm, you can have a dinner at a local restaurant along the pier and walk your way back to hotel.

DAY 10 / OCT 17, 2020

FULL DAY KURANDA TOUR

(B)

After breakfast and meet your guide and transfer from hotel to Freshwater Station where you board the historic Kuranda Scenic train (One Way) on a scenic climb to the beautiful town of Kuranda. The views over the sugar cane fields to the rainforest above Cairns are truly spectacular. Cross the Stony Creek Bridge and stop to view Barron Falls. After disembarking the train re-board your coach for the short transfer to Rainforestation Nature Park, boasting 40 hectares of gardens and rainforest set amidst World Heritage areas.

The Dreamtime Walk provides a comprehensive introduction to Aboriginal and Islander culture and history with practical experiences including **boomerang** lessons on spear **throwing**. Witness the dynamic performance of the **Pamagirri Aboriginal Dancers** in the natural amphitheatre where the rainforest serves as the theatre walls and the sounds of the forest and the didgeridoo create the backing music. A **BBQ lunch** will be served during the day (beverages at own expense).

At the end of the visit we depart Rainforestation and return to Kuranda to the Skyrail terminal. You board the **Skyrail Rainforest Cableway** for an amazing experience over Australia's World Heritage listed Tropical Rainforest canopy and deep into the forest. Your Skyrail experience should take approximately 1.5 hours and includes spending time at the two rainforest mid-stations. Allow 20 minutes for each station, to enjoy the boardwalk tours and visit the Rainforest Interpretation Centre, lookouts and historical displays. On arrival at your last stop re-board the coach for transfer back to the hotel.

DAY 11/ OCT 18, 2020 FLY CAIRNS TO AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND (B)

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight back to your next destination Auckland, New Zealand.

Kia Ora and welcome to New Zealand! On arrival in Auckland you will be met by local guide and transferred by private coach to your hotel to check in and the rest of the day is at your leisure.

DAY 12/ OCT 19, 2020 AUCKLAND SIGHTS (B, L)

After breakfast we depart for **Auckland City tour** start with a trip along Queen Street, the "Golden Mile" of Auckland's business and shopping district. Many of the early buildings dating back to the 1880s still remain, threaded amongst the modern high-rise buildings of today. Then we travel across **Auckland's Harbour Bridge** for expansive views of Waitemata Harbour, boat marinas and the city skyline. The city has 48 extinct volcanic sites, many of which you'll see on your tour.



We will visit **Auckland Domain**, one of Auckland's oldest parks. Within its 75 hectares you'll find the Auckland War Memorial Museum and the tropical Winter Gardens. Your tour continues through the boutique shopping area of Parnell, before travelling along the waterfront on Tamaki. We drive to the perfect spot for photo

opportunities: Michael Joseph Savage Memorial Park on Bastion Point. From this outlook you'll be able to enjoy stunning views of the city skyline and across the Waitemata Harbour.

You will be dropped off at Auckland's Viaduct harbour. Please make your own way to the Explore NZ Kiosk located inside Auckland's Viaduct Harbour at the end of Quay St, adjacent to the Voyager Maritime Museum and next to The Original Restaurant. Please arrive and check-in for **Harbour Sailing Cruise with Lunch** at least 15 minutes prior to departure time and the cruise departure time 12:00pm. You will experience the sights and delights of the city from the water on board your purpose built yacht while listening to an informative commentary. After a sailor's lunch enjoy the fun and pleasure of 'hands-on' sailing (where possible) in the sailing capital of the world.

Note: Credit card facilities are not available on board, you will need to pay cash (\$NZD) for beverages.

After the cruise, we transfer by coach back to your hotel and the remainder of the day is at leisure.

DAY 13 / OCT 20, 2020 AUCKLAND TO ROTORUA VIA WAITOMO (B)

After breakfast, we check out of the hotel and we have a private transfer to Rotorua.

On the way to Waitomo Caves, pass through the beautiful countryside of the Waikato and King Country. Your experienced driver will tell you about New Zealand and the extraordinary places you will see along the approximately 2.5 hour journey from Auckland to the **Waitomo Glowworm Caves**. At Waitomo, you will experience the world-famous Glowworm Caves on a 45-minute tour, which includes a boat ride on an underground stream to view the magically dazzling Glowworms.
