POSITION SUMMARY

The Concession Lead demonstrates positive work habits to the staff, and provides input into scheduling needs, and organizing volunteers, in addition to being mainly involved in the concession food preparation and serving. The Concession Lead will also maintain inventory, will control costs and ensure appropriate cleaning procedures are adhered to. They are ambassadors of the club and are there to ensure guests have a successful food experience. The work is dependent on customer demand, with very busy times punctuated with down times, daily and week by week.

- ~ Have an outgoing, approachable and friendly personality and show a commitment to exceeding guest expectations at all times.
- ~ Well-developed interpersonal skills to interact with customers of various ages with animation and patience.

WORKING CONDITIONS

- ~ Adhere to all AHS standards at all times, without exception.
- ~ Safely climb ladders.
- ~ Prepare food using high temperature appliances (eg. stove, oven, grill, deep fryer).
- ~ This position is seasonal and includes working on weeknights, weekends and holidays, in addition to some weekdays.
- ~ An up to date and clean Vulnerable Sector Check and Intervention Record Check are required for anyone over 18 years of age
- ~ Must be willing to work up to and possibly more than 40 hours / week as needed, as the length of the working day will vary
- ~ Ability to work in a standing position for long periods of time and be able to be on feet throughout a 8 + hour day.
- ~ May push and/or pull items up to 50 lbs. on an occasional basis.
- ~ May lift and/or carry items up to 35 lbs. on a regular basis.
- ~ This position requires stooping and lifting, substantial standing and walking.

PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS

- ~ Applicant must have a Food Safety Certificate from a course approved in Alberta issued within the last 5 years prior to start date.
- ~ Hands on experience of food and beverage operations.
- ~ Basic math ability to accurately count and handle money.
- ~ Positive attitude and a neat and clean appearance.
- ~ Ability to follow directions and effectively perform work requirements.
- ~ Must at all times be fit for duty and not under the influence of any forms of drugs or alcohol be it prescription or recreational
- All staff over 18 will be part of the evacuation team and must be fit for duty to climb towers and ladders, properly rig evacuation belay devices, ensuring all components are in correct operational status, and be responsible for the lives of our patrons
