POSITION SUMMARY

Ski and Snowboard Instructors have the enviable job of spending their days on the slopes. These patient individuals teach everyone from wee tots to active seniors how to improve their skiing and snowboarding skills. They are also ambassadors on the mountain to ensure guests have a successful day and will return. Instructors are an integral part of our team and when lesson demand is low they are assigned alternate work assignments in a variety of departments.

SKILLS, INTERESTS AND VALUES

- ~ Have an outgoing, friendly personality and show a commitment to exceeding guest expectations at all times.
- ~ Well-developed interpersonal skills to interact with customers of various ages with animation and patience.
- ~ The ability to motivate students through positive reinforcement and encouragement.
- ~ Ability to remain composed when faced with unexpected problems and stressful situations.
- ~ Remain courteous, patient and tactful when dealing with difficult guests.
- ~ Enjoy working with and meeting a variety of people.

WORKING CONDITIONS

- ~ Teach the basic rules and strategies of the sport and organize events in which guests may demonstrate and build confidence in their abilities as per CSIA/CASI/CADS standards.
- ~ Safely climb ladders
- ~ Safe use of lifts as a passenger and safely take patrons of all reasonable ability up the lifts
- ~ This position is seasonal and includes working on weeknights, weekends and holidays.
- ~ The number of hours worked is dependent on the instructors availability and consumer demand for lessons.
- ~ May lift, push or carry students weighing over 50 pounds on a frequent basis.
- ~ Exposed to changes of temperature from work both indoors and outdoors.
- ~ A clean, up to date Vulnerable Sector Check and Intervention Record Check are required for anyone 18 years of age or older.

PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS

- ~ Minimum level 1 Canadian Ski Instructors' Alliance (CSIA) / Canadian Association of Snowboard Instructors (CASI) or equivalent is required. A background in physical education or experience in teaching is an asset. Instructors are required to have and maintain professional certification by payment of dues and attendance at recall. (Minimum age for certification is 15 years of age)
- ~ Must at all times be fit for duty and not under the influence of any forms of drugs or alcohol be it prescription or recreational
- ~ All staff over 18 will be part of the evacuation team and must be fit for duty to climb towers and ladders, properly rig evacuation belay devices, ensuring all components are in correct operational status, and be responsible for the lives of our patrons
