POSITION SUMMARY

Lift operators are responsible for the safe and efficient operation of the T-Bar and/or the Chairlift and the customers that use them. They spend their days helping customers, of all skill levels, load and unload, in all kinds of weather. As a result, enjoyment of the outdoors is a must! The job of a lift operator is critical to the success of any ski operation because much of the customer's time is spent with them.

SKILLS, INTERESTS AND VALUES

- Intermediate level skiing or snowboarding ability is preferred but not necessary.
- ~ Have an outgoing, approachable and friendly personality and show a commitment to exceeding guest expectations at all times.
- ~ Well-developed interpersonal skills to interact with customers of various ages with animation and patience.
- ~ Ability to remain composed when faced with unexpected problems and stressful situations.
- ~ Able to reason and react with quick, thoughtful judgement, while remaining calm under pressure.
- ~ Community involvement would be considered an asset.

WORKING CONDITIONS

- ~ The length of a working day may vary depending on how busy the area is or deadlines that need to be met for a particular project.
- This position is seasonal and includes working on weeknights, weekends and holidays.
- ~ Ability to work in a standing position for the majority of the scheduled shift on slippery and/or uneven hard packed surfaces.
- ~ May lift &/or carry items up to 34 pounds on a frequent basis.
- ~ May push &/or pull items up 10 pounds on an occasional basis.
- ~ Must remain alert and attentive at all times.
- Shoveling large volumes of snow and/or hard pack is required.
- Operate machinery as per Z98-14 safety code regulations.
- ~ Working outside in all weather conditions, including extreme cold, snow, wind and rain.
- ~ An up to date, and clean, Vulnerable Sector Check and Intervention Record Check are required
- ~ Safely climb towers and ladders.
- ~ Safely operate ATV's, only if asked to by a manager.
- ~ Be responsible for the lives of passengers utilizing the lifts
- ~ Safely operate power tools.

PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Experience in operating at T-Bar and/or Chairlift at a ski area is an asset. There are no standard educational requirements for this position due to the seasonal and part time nature of the position and most training is completed on the job. Experience in High Angle Rescue would be an asset.
- ~ Must at all times be fit for duty and not under the influence of any forms of drugs or alcohol be it prescription or recreational
- ~ All staff over 18 will be part of the evacuation team and must be fit for duty to climb towers and ladders, properly rig evacuation belay devices, ensuring all components are in correct operational status, and be responsible for the lives of our patrons
