



MHSEF Continuing Education Scholarship

The Mead High School Education Foundation will award two (2) **\$1000 scholarships** to graduating seniors from Mead High School in 2019.

Students who meet the following criteria are encouraged to apply:

- Applicant must be a Mead High School graduating senior and have been enrolled full-time at MHS throughout their senior year.
- Applicant must become a full-time student at a two- or four-year college/university or vocational/trade school in the fall of their MHS graduation year. Funds will be dispersed directly to the institution.

Application requirements:

- Applicant must complete an essay response to one of the following prompts:

Describe an educational experience you have had at Mead High School and how that experience has prepared you for your future?

Rubric:

- Essay must be typed, single-spaced, 12-font Times New Roman, and be at least one-page, but no more than two-pages in length.
- Essay must begin by stating the prompt that is chosen.
- Content
- Literacy (proper grammar, spacing, punctuation and spelling)
- Creativity
- Developed ideas – What and Why? (ideas that are supported and possible)

Instructions:

- *To insure anonymity and fairness in the selection process, please do not reference student or parent names in the essay.*
- A faculty member who is aware of your contributions and supports your application must read the essay and sign the application form that they have done so.
- The applicant AND their parent or guardian must sign the application form, thus verifying that the essay is the student's original work.
- The application form and the essay must be delivered to the MHS Counseling Office, Attn: Andi Felton, no later than 2:30pm on Friday, April 5, 2019. Applications will not be considered after this deadline.

Scholarship recipients will be announced at Senior Recognition Night on May 22, 2019.
