

Basic Emergency Preparedness I

Short Description: If an emergency or disaster struck, would you and your family be prepared? Or what would happen if your electricity, water, heating or cooling is out for multiple days? This course will give you the basic information you need to prepare to keep your family safe in the event a disaster or outage does strike.

More Details: This is a three-hour course for basic emergency or disaster preparedness that will cover subjects such as your first move in disaster preparation, tools and equipment, your plan, sheltering and defense in different locations, water storage and disinfection, food, energy, hygiene and first aid, communication and special considerations. All activities are held in a classroom setting.
