

Orientation to Fly Fishing

Short Description: Fly fishing introduction, techniques, gear, and safety.

More Details: This is a three-hour (with additional live practice time) course for fly fishing that is conducted in the classroom with a live practice component. Students are taught the safety aspects of fly fishing; gear for fly fishing; uses of gear; fly types; fly uses; casting; and where to go for fly fishing. This class is designed for those that have very little or no fly fishing experience and want to become more comfortable in this environment. This class is for those that have questions they were curious about and where afraid to ask. Please bring your questions if you want to know something specific about any of the subjects covered in this class. We are eager to help start taking the mystery out of fly fishing for you. This class does NOT include any fly fishing. All activities are held in a classroom setting or practicing casting skills.
