Trying something different.

Ever want to try a technique, but maybe the uTube video didn't spell it out well enough? I had that experience recently and tried a paint pouring class, the one where all the paint goes in the cup, then upend the cup on the canvas. I didn't want to try it on my own, heck the clean up scared me as much as the process. And of course, I messed it up, but I'm glad it did it. UTube and Pintrest are great resources to whittle down some ideas, see how it's done, then decide if you want to give it a try. Either look to our Artful Touch or other local classes to get that first taste to see if you want to dive in. Make 2018 the year you say, "I'm trying that!

January 2018 Artful Touch Intro to Pastels - Underpainting for Landscapes with Siobhan Duggan

Wednesday, January 17 - 6:30 to 8:30pm. 310 Walnut Street, Milton, DE Whether you are a beginner or have some experience with pastels, this class immerses you into the rich world of pastels and acrylic. Creating bold underpaintings based on values and basic shapes, then adding layers of pastels to result in vibrant work on sanded card stock. Participants are invited to bring their own pastels (if they have them) and a photo reference. There will be a \$5.00 materials fee for this class. Limit - 12 students.
