The intuitive Lightroom CC interface offers you editing in full-resolution anywhere – on mobile devices, the web, or your desktop. Edits on one device are automatically applied everywhere else. Ray will provide an introduction to the Adobe Lightroom application., a powerful tool for cataloging, editing, and printing digital images. Demos will be provided for the Lightroom Library, Develop, and Print modules
