## June's Artful Touch – Wednesday June 20th Acrylic Negative Painting with Kathy Fessenbecker



Negative painting is an intriguing, alternative approach. The subject is established by painting around the object, instead of painting the object itself.

Beginning by covering paper with a variety of random brush strokes in acrylic, the subject begins to "appear" as painting the background "carves" the subject to the forefront.

This method works in many mediums and is a helpful approach to any composition.
