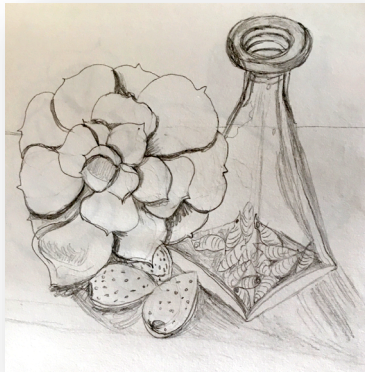


Foundations of Drawing with Joe Terrone
