Mounting Art on Wood Blocks with Sally Reed

You've painted your watercolor or acrylic. Now the question is how to show it off. Using a few finishing products, Sally demonstrates how artwork can be mounted onto birch blocks or panels, avoiding costly frames and heavy, breakable glass. Bring your own watercolor, acrylic, or other artwork. You'll be cropping the image to mount on a 3"x 3" block.

MAG will provide the blocks plus the remaining products to adhere and preserve your work.

Putting Pencil to Paper!

When I started art classes, one tool I didn't have in my toolbox was drawing. I just couldn't wait to swirl color and see what I imagined come to life. But sometimes, many times, there was just something wrong. Too often, the drawing or composition was just off enough in some way to throw everything out of whack.

I dídn't possess knowledge of a building block of art, drawing. Frankly, I was afraid of drawing.

But I've learned drawing isn't some special inborn talent, you can learn how to do it, and do it well.

Joe Terrone's drawing class opened a new world for me. He's a great teacher, patient and encouraging, ready to help you get to the next level. Everyday I use something I learned in class. I even entered a drawing in a show.

Remember using a pencil also means getting to use an eraser...and now they even have "electric" erasers!
