iPhone Photography & Editing - Paul & Sharon Hammesfahr

Paul and Sharon Hammesfahr share simple yet effective techniques plus versatile editing of your iPhone photos. Using the hidden editing effects native on your iPhone, we'll show you how to turn your snapshot into creative, interesting images. In addition, relatively inexpensive additional lenses for special effects can broaden the iPhone capabilities.

NOTE: This class covers the basic & advanced editing of your photos using existing iPhone software. While editing using Android devices is quite similar, only iPhone specific examples will be demonstrated.

MAG Bites

Color of 2019!

Each year Pantone names a Color of the Year, this year it's Living Coral. For those of you who've flipped through the color pack, it's 16-1546. I personally love this color. It speaks to me of life, beauty, and hopefully the future.

A little research on this color produced a few tips on "how to mix it." There are some uTube videos from The Art Sherpa that show you how. But for now here are some Cliff notes to get you started. In watercolor, mix pyrrol orange, pyrrol red, and a hint of quin magenta using the white of the paper to get you there. In Acrylic, reach for primary red, primary yellow and titanium white, experiment by creating the orange then add in the white to get there. In Oil, lemon yellow added to rose and lightened with ivory white gets you close.

As our coral reefs are endangered by everything from climate change to sunscreen, lets hope bringing this color to the forefront makes us all mindful of one our most beautiful natural resources.
