#### MAG Bites

#### Plein Aire – How to get out there and paint! OK, I'm gonna try it again!

On the occasions I've "tried", my small, cheap backpack is packed with paints, brushes, small papers, pencil, eraser, paper towels, rags, plus snacks & water bottles. Not too heavy, it fits in my bike basket. I watercolor, so I found using Daniel Smith watercolor sticks greatcompact, don't "run", and easy to pack. Plus if you are traveling TSA doesn't give them a second look. Cheap Joes and Winsor Newton also have a line of these products. Old contact lens containers are great to carry squirts of color. I even had one class where the teacher walked to ocean and dipped up her water from the sea. Things that make you go hummm! I can't speak with any authority on acrylic or oils, but check with our members who use these mediums to get their best tips. I know lightweight easels, canvas carriers, air-tight palettes are important. Our Artwalk will give many members the opportunity to either try this or show their stuff. But me, I'm gonna get out there AGAIN and try to hone my Plein Aire skills, mainly so I don't get frustrated on that day! Even if whatever I get down on paper is not too good, I'll enjoy participating in this inaugural event for MAG. The best news, I'll be close to a bathroom!
