Working in Oil, you'll need: Titanium white, cadmium lemon, Cad yellow pale, Cad yellow hue, Scarlet lake, Permanent Rose, Burnt Umber, Ultramarine blue, and Cobalt blue. A 9x12 or 10x12 white gessoed board. Roger uses Zest-It as a non-toxic solvent for oil. If painting in another medium, try to match pallet colors listed and surface at suggested size.
