Tuition Policy

All tuition is due on the first lesson of each month. Payment in advance is expected unless other arrangements have been made. When making a cash payment place monies in an envelope (available at desk) with the students name on the front and please ask for a receipt. If for some reason you are unable to attend all of your classes of the month in which you have paid, you must make-up in another class. There are no refunds for missed classes. These classes should be made up in the same month in which they were missed. Please check with your teacher for suggested make-up times. **Do not** prorate monthly tuitions. All classes have been scheduled so as to average a four lesson month. **November and December are full tuition months and have been compensated for in other months.** June tuition will be one half the usual fee and will be collected with May tuition. A fee of \$10 per month will be charged if tuition payment is not received in the month it is due. You must notify the office of any changes in the month prior to the change or you will be charged the full amount if you have dropped a class or withdrawing entirely. No student with an outstanding tuition balance will be allowed to participate in our spring performances. A \$20 fee will be assessed on all returned checks.
