

Light Truck High Flotation

Light truck high flotation tires evolved in the mid-seventies as lower aspect ratio tires became more popular on light trucks and vans. The combination of lower aspect ratios and high flotation yielded better traction on sand and soft soil found in watery off-road situations.

Example: 31X10.50R15LT/C

- 31 = Tire Diameter in Inches
- 10.50 = Section Width in Millimeters
- R = Radial Construction
- LT = Light Truck Tire
- 15 = Rim Diameter in Inches
- C = Road Range
