All classes take place in the Glass Endeavors studio
at 2716 E. 31st St., Minneapolis.

Introduction to Fusing - \$150 January 3rd, Tuesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Students will complete 4 to 5 different projects - including pendants, tiles, plates and bowls. You'll be loading, programming and firing in our kilns to tack, contour or full fuse and slump. Bring cutting and breaking tools for the first night of class. If you haven't cut glass before, we'll teach you how. No experience necessary.

Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 January 4th, Wednesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8:30pm

Make a small panel using one of many patterns the studio provides. You will learn glass cutting techniques, how to use special tools designed for stained glass artists and construct your panel using the copper foil technique. Tool kit includes an 80W soldering iron, running and grozing pliers, 1# 50/50 solder, carbide steel glass cutter, flux, flux brush and black pen. It is discounted from \$173 to \$147 for our students. Other materials for this class run \$80 on average over the 4 week class. Stop in before the first class to pick your pattern and select glass. No experience necessary.

Leaded Windows - \$75 January 7th, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 12:30pm

Learn how to construct windows using lead came and zinc. We'll discuss reinforcement using rebar and appropriate designs for leaded windows. You will need a soldering iron, lead cutter, glass cutter, pliers and glass supplies for your window. Beginning Stained Glass required.

FEBRUARY 2017

Frit Slurry Flowers - \$55 February 1st, Wednesdays, 2 weeks, 6 - 8pm

It's never too early to start planning for an amazing spring garden, and this class will help you with your first blooms. Using only powdered frits, a sheet of clear glass and a bit of imagination, students will construct wonderfully organic fused flowers that can be mounted to a wall or attached to a copper rod and planted among the roses. No experience necessary.

Panel Lamp Shade - February 4th, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 12:30pm

You will learn about design, construction and techniques for successful panel lamp building. Come in prior to the first class to select your pattern and glass so that you're ready to cut the first day of class. Beginning Stained Glass is required. Tiffany Form Lamp - \$85 - Thurs, February 9th, Wednesdays, March 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, 6 weeks, 6:00 - 8:00pm

Build a beautiful Tiffany lamp shade using the Odyssey form system. We will discuss how to choose and use art glass in your lamp and take you through all the steps of building on the lamp form, soldering, adding rims and rings and constructing a lamp holder to make soldering easy. We will skip 2 weeks after the first class to allow time to cut your glass. Class resumes March 1st. Come in prior to Feb 9th to select your lamp design. Panel Lamp class required.

Fused/Cast Switch Plates - \$45 February 15th, Wednesdays, 2 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Time for some truly practical fused glass art. Switch out your boring, white switch plate covers for something genuinely one of a kind. Students will learn how to create delicate powder frit wafers of glass, then incorporate them into one of several styles of switch plate molds. No experience necessary.
