All classes take place in the Glass Endeavors studio
at 2716 E. 31st St., Minneapolis.

Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 March 4th, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 1pm

Make a small panel using one of many patterns the studio provides. Learn glass cutting techniques, how to use stained glass tools and construct your panel using the copper foil technique. Tool kit includes a soldering iron, running and grozing pliers, 1# 50/50 solder, carbide steel glass cutter, flux, flux brush and black pen - discounted to \$111 for students. Other materials for this class run \$80 on average over the 4 week class. Stop in before the first class to pick your pattern and select glass. No experience necessary.

Bead Bars - \$65 March 7th, Tuesdays, 3 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Become a professional at making multi-layered, wearable art. During this class you will learn about using reactive glass and metals for eye catching results and we'll discuss kiln programming for more mass. We'll demonstrate how to use a glass saw and provide schedules for full fusing the bars and fire polishing. Bring cutting and breaking tools and 96 C.O.E. glass and supplies if you have them, or purchase them at class time. No experience necessary.

Coral Sea Bowl - \$45 March 28th, Tuesday, 1 week, 6 - 8pm

Spend a relaxing evening cutting and assembling strips of beautiful glass that will make an organic piece that looks like it came from under the sea. Choose from our fusible 96 C.O.E. sheet glass that offers endless color combinations and is easy to cut. We will full fuse your pieces and then drape them into bowl shapes for you. No experience necessary.

APRIL 2017

Reproducing Images on Glass - \$55 April 1st, Saturdays, 2 weeks, 10:30am - 12:30pm

Through photo fusing you can add detail and a custom touch to your fused and stained glass work. Fire high quality photos, graphics or text onto fusible or stained glass. This process enables you to collage a variety of ideas into one piece and gives you more creative choices for your art work. Bring cutting and breaking tools and System 96 glass and supplies if you have them, or purchase them at class time.

No experience necessary.

Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 April 4th, Tuesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8:30pm

Color and Design - April 5th, \$60 Wednesdays, 3 weeks, 6 - 8pm

We will discuss the elements of color and design in art through art history and your own designs for glass art. The first week will be lecture and discussion of the principles of color and design with a slide presentation. The following two weeks will be development and critique of your designs with review and discussion of color and design principles. Bring a notepad and pen and designs you would like to adapt for future stained glass windows. No experience necessary.

Watercolor Edge Up Sculpture - \$45 - April 15th, Saturdays, 2 weeks, 10:30am - 12:30pm

Assemble an eye-catching sculptural piece using thick, clear glass strips and bits of crushed glass. We'll fuse them for you so you will be ready to color them in week two. If you've never cut glass before we'll show you how. Glass, colorants and one firing provided. Display stands not included. No experience necessary.

Flower Pot & Garden Spikes - \$45 April 26th, Wednesday, 1 week, 6 - 8pm

Assemble decorative spikes for your house planters or to identify the rows in your garden this spring. Using fusible glass, frit and rods, the sky is the limit on ways to decorate these cuties. We'll fuse them for you and they'll be available for pick up the following week. Bring cutting and breaking tools and 96 C.O.E. glass and supplies if you have them, or purchase them at class time. No experience necessary.
