Rendering Mosaics Like Tiffany - \$75 January 2nd, Tuesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Create two mosaic projects inspired by the artistry of works created by L. C. Tiffany while gaining a new understanding of how to render light, shadow, space and shape with glass. One project will be unlit mosaic and the other glass-on-glass. Beginning Stained Glass suggested but not required.

Leaded Window - \$75 January 6, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 12:30pm

Learn to construct windows using the traditional lead came method. You will need a soldering iron, lead cutter, glass cutter, pliers and glass supplies for your window. Students bring their own pattern - no larger than 18" x 24" and 30 pieces or fewer. Stop in before the first class to discuss your pattern. Beginning Stained Glass required.

Beginning Stained Glass - January 10th, Wednesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8:30pm

Make a panel using the copper foil technique. Learn glass cutting, breaking and soldering. Stop in before the first class to pick your pattern, select and purchase glass (price varies) and purchase your tool kit (dis-counted to \$111). Other materials run \$80 on average over the 4 week class. No experience necessary. *This class is offered through School District 196 and held at Glass Endeavors. Tiffany Form Lamp - \$85 - February 7th, March 7, 14, 21, 28, Wednesdays, 5 weeks, 6:00 - 8:00pm

Build a beautiful Tiffany lamp shade using the Odyssey form system. We will discuss how to choose and use art glass in your lamp and take you through all the steps of building on the lamp form, soldering, adding rims and rings and constructing a lamp holder to make soldering easy. We will skip 3 weeks after the first class to allow time to cut your glass. Class resumes March 7th. Come in prior to Feb 7th to select your lamp design. Panel Lamp class required.

Panel Lampshades - February 13th, Tuesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8pm

You will learn design, construction and techniques for successful panel lamp building. Stop in ahead of time to discuss your pattern and pick out glass. Beginning stained glass is required. *This class is offered through Roosevelt Community Education and held at Glass Endeavors. Stained Glass Painted Panels - \$75 February 14th, Wednesdays, 3 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Learn the thousand-year-old tradition of painting on glass. We will talk about and practice design and painting techniques using trace, matte and stain. Class includes paint and kiln firing. Please select cathedral glass on which to paint and incorporate into a window. Beginning Stained Glass required.
