### **Panel Lamp - May 1st, Tuesdays, 4 weeks, 6:00 - 8:00pm**

You will learn design, construction and techniques for successful panel lamp building. Stop in ahead of time to discuss your pattern and select glass appropriate for your shade. Beginning stained glass is required. *This class is offered through Roosevelt Community Education and held at Glass Endeavors. ### **Mosaic Gazing Ball - May 2nd, Wednesdays, 4 weeks, 6:00 - 8:00pm**

Share Wednesday evenings in May with us making a striking gazing ball for your garden. We will guide you through designing, glass cutting, the direct mosaic process and grouting and sealing your garden art. Beginners are welcome, but if you have scrap glass, cutting tools, or a mosaic nipper, bring them along. We will provide a ball to mosaic. Found objects and dimensional glass pieces make nice added embellishments, too (such as sea glass, metal sundries or small cast glass pieces). A supply fee of \$30 will provide scrap glass, grout and sealer. No experience needed *This class is offered through School District 196 and held at Glass Endeavors. ### **Beginning Stained Glass - May 5th, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 1:00pm**

Make a panel using the copper foil technique. Learn glass cutting, breaking and soldering. Stop in before the first class to pick your pattern, select and purchase glass (price varies) and purchase your tool kit (discounted to \$121.29). Other materials for the beginner panel run \$80 on average over the 4 week class. No experience needed. *This class is offered through Roosevelt Community Education and held at Glass Endeavors. ### **Edge Up Bowl - \$75 May 29th, Tuesday, 1 evening, 4:00 - 8:00pm**

Assemble a bowl using glass strips and bits of rods. This is a terrific project where you can create something amazing in a relatively short period of time. Just bring a bit of patience and some tweezers. Purchase of 1 sheet of glass and 1 glass rod is all that is generally needed for one bowl. No experience needed.

### **Mosaic Totem - \$55 June 2nd, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 12:30pm**

Our new mosaic totem is a must have for your yard! Turn a 4 x 4 post into something truly eye catching. Once your garden art design is drawn, we'll cover all of the direct glass mosaic techniques, including grouting and sealing. Purchase your own post (4 x 4 cedar or pressure treated, 4' long) and square cap prior to class. A \$20 materials fee covers adhesive/grout, colorant and sealer. Purchase of glass not included. No experience needed.

### **Leaded Window - \$85 June 5th, Tuesdays, 4 weeks, 6:00 - 8:00pm**

Build big windows with the grace and elegance of the old masters. Learn to create a leaded window using centuries old techniques with the addition of a few modern developments. Students are encouraged to come in before class to choose their pattern or have one approved by staff. Students purchase their own glass, materials and tools. Beginning stained glass required.

### **Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 June 6th, Wednesdays, 4 weeks, 6:00 - 8:30pm**

Make a panel using the copper foil technique. Learn glass cutting, breaking and soldering. You'll finish with patinas, polish and leave class with a beautiful completed panel. Stop in before the first class to pick your pattern, select and purchase glass (price varies) and purchase your tool kit (discounted to \$121.29). Other materials for the beginner panel run \$80 on average over the 4 week class. No experience needed.
