Instead, he made a surprise arrival a few minutes later in a Riverside Police helicopter with siren and flashing lights, to cheers of delight from the little ones.

"Santa" was a young, slender Highway Patrol officer who in his teens volunteered at this event with his mother and father. Children didn't notice that the suit was way too big for its occupant, who struggled to keep his hat and beard in place as helicopter blades nearly blew them off!
