Sewer Update

We are still in the process of obtaining resolution to a few key questions....questions that ultimately could have a major impact on the cost structure of the project.

What we are fairly sure of at this point is that the entire property will be required to hookup to the main sewer line not just the septic system on the A St. side that has failed.

Until such time that we have our responsibilities made clear by our engineer and the county, any costs and operational disturbances can only be speculated on but we hope to keep them at a level that is only extremely high....not severe.
