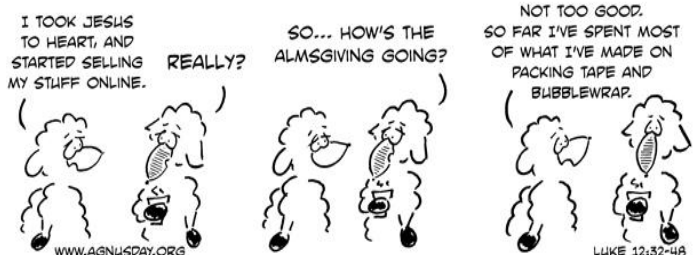


## You scream, I scream, we all scream for Ice Cream
