#### Am I your neighbor?

Have you ever stopped to consider who you're sitting next to in worship on Sunday mornings? Everyone has a different way of preparing themselves for worship. Some prefer a quiet space while others listen to spiritual or uplifting music. Others may choose to read Scripture or silently pray. Some do a combination of these things. Please consider those around you in the sanctuary before and during worship.

Recently at Spanaway Lutheran Church I've noticed that have become incredibly social, both before and during worship. As much as I appreciate a great conversation with someone I've missed for a week or two, I'm not sure worship is the most considerate time for catching up with people. Don't get me wrong, I'm a very social person and greatly appreciate the time spent with all of you in the fellowship hall after worship over a cup of coffee and cookies. We have plenty of time for that.

I personally have a difficult time staying focused both in song and liturgy as my mind can wander off to things that need doing when I arrive at home or to a gathering I attended recently. Some of us enter the sanctuary seeking peace, silence, and the presence of God. When the complete chaos in the narthex continues to crash through the doors, it becomes very difficult to quiet one's mind and heart. Even when the prelude begins people don't quiet themselves; they talk even louder. (This isn't only during preludes and postludes. It happens during congregational singing and during the special music that our musicians have prepared.) Often during the special music selection I will get a tap on the shoulder, only to have someone ask about a recent trip, a family member, or an upcoming event. I look forward to hearing the special music, and I know that those playing or singing have given a great deal of their time and of themselves selecting, practicing and presenting each piece. When people chat over the music it seems as though they aren't honoring that person's offering to God. Please take time to consider those around you.
