Lutheran Marriage Encounter May 31-June 2 Renton, WA



This is the third growing season at the Spanaway Lutheran Community Garden and it is a wonderful sight to behold. Michael Luberts built an additional 23 beds to increase our growing space from 27 to 50 beds. There are 18 hills for squash and long vining plants. There is an eighty foot long bed along the driveway in front of the grape trellis. Thank you Michael Luberts for tirelessly working to bring this garden to life! He has held firm to the vision of the garden and done most of the building by himself!

There are also 11 fruit trees, 9 blueberry bushes, a row of raspberries, grape plants, rhubarb, a bed of strawberries, a bed of garlic and shallots, and an herb spiral.

This spring gardeners signed up quickly for all 50 garden beds, and 3/4 of them are being used by community members. Several gardeners are growing for the food banks. The Spanaway Lutheran Garden Club is growing two beds of flowers for the church. A Community member named Mike Kander planted the entire eighty foot long bed with an assortment of flowers and perennials.

The garden has also supported three Eagle Scout Projects. Sam Wright- Osborn built a trail and a compost station, Alex Wildfang built a tall handicap-accessible raised bed, and Kory Nieto built a permanent wood and metal fence along B Street and will be planting grapes on the grape trellis as soon as those plants become available.

Thank you to everyone who has supported this project. It has truly been a community outreach project that has reached out into the immediate neighborhood community and also into the greater Pierce County community and numerous Garden networks in which we have had so many meetings and received so much free information and materials.

Thank you to Gayle Halmo, Tim Tengesdal and Elois McDonald and Angie Rivera for all your help on the Community Garden Committee. Thank you to everyone who has showed up to move countless yards of soil and woodchips—72 yards in the new part of the garden this spring alone!!!

Thank you to Tracy Nieto for digging so many holes and planting trees and berries.

Thank you to Paul Matthias for mowing the grass--there is much less grass now.

Thank you to everyone in the congregation who has supported this endeavor!

I was in the garden yesterday and met a gardener who is not a member of Spanaway Lutheran. She stops by the garden twice a day as she commutes to and from work. She radiated absolute joy and enthusiasm and she told me over and over again that the garden is her happy place. When she is there she feels completely at peace and happy. She talks to her plants and realized one afternoon there was a neighbor watching her. Embarrassed, she waved and he motioned for her to come over. He told her has been watching the garden develop these past few years and he just can't express how it has made his life in the neighborhood so much better. The place that was once an eyesore and a magnet for trouble is now a peaceful, lovely place. She said, "Thank you (Spanaway Lutheran) for doing this. It is so generous. When I am here no matter what else is going on my trouble slips away."

Praise God! He meets people where they are.

Eagle Project Completed!


