Thanks for Your Patience

We know the lack of bathroom facilities has been a burden for many of us and the Council wants to briefly share what the issue has been and also where we are headed.

Last winter we began experiencing drain issues inside the building and after dealing with those we found that there were also septic tank problems which lead to the discovery of drain field failure as well. We diligently attempted to deal with each issue but ultimately found the drain field was not salvageable after a concerted effort to rehabilitate it.

County regulations do not allow a drain field to be re-engineered and installed if a property is within 300 ft. of a sewer trunk line which in our situation is the case since the sewer runs along B St.

We have now engaged a sewer engineer and are currently involved in the preliminary phase of making provision to ultimately connect to the sewer. The first step in this process is making application to the Health Department for what is called a Letter of Sewer Availability and we have taken that step.

Again, thank you for your patience and understanding as we get on with this process.
