During These Troubled Times



²⁵ Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful. ²⁴ And let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good deeds, ²⁵ ... but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day approaching. Hebrews 10:23-25

Monday evening Governor Inslee officially decreed that all people in Washington State not performing essential functions should shelter in our homes. The suggestion that we shelter in our homes sounds nonthreatening, innocuous, almost vacation like, but in reality most people will find themselves isolated, and away from their support network of friends, neighbors and colleagues. Living in imposed isolation during uncertain times provides a fertile environment in which doubt, anxiety, and depression can take hold.

The best way to prevent too much time by ourselves from leading to cycles of emotional distress involves maintaining regular human contact with people from outside our circumstances. The letter to the Hebrews instructs the faithful in the first generation of believers to encourage one another, even provoke each other to good deeds. The intent is to provide a hope and purpose believers as they awaited liberation from the imprisonment in this sinful world at Jesus' return.

Their circumstances being not so very different from ours at the moment, it seems that the same course of action prescribed for them in Hebrews would be an appropriate course for all of us in the present crisis. The council is of a mind that during this time we should set up an intentional phone network so that we can check on each other, encourage one another, and remind ourselves that we are neither alone, not lacking purpose in these unusual days. Members of the Church Council are willing to take a lead role in contacting members of the congregation regularly, but you may also discern that this is something you would also wish to participate in. Envision this as an opportunity to become better acquainted with members of the congregation you may not know well. If you are interested in this ministry, please contact the church office (253-531-7000) and let Stefanie know you would like to participate.

If you are opposed to being contacted by another member of the congregation, we would also like to have that information, so that your wishes can be honored. I envision the calls to be brief check-ins, occasionally spreading important information, and ways of encouraging and fostering new bonds of friendship and support within the Spanaway Lutheran family.

Once we set the parameters of this shepherding ministry in place, all those who have expressed an interest in participating will be contacted, and provided with a group of members to contact regularly, and the basic guidelines and expectations for sharing in this work.

I will also be reaching out to members by phone for all the same reasons, but I encourage your participation, because there can never be too much of a good thing. *"Let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good deeds, ... encouraging one another."*

Stewardship Options While Sheltering at Home

As a result of the corona virus we have all now been asked to shelter in our homes until further notice. That obviously makes gathering for worship impossible for the foreseeable future, as has been the case for the last two Sundays. Even so, the work of the congregation goes on as Stefanie, Cheryl and Pastor pioneer new forms for providing worship online; as SLC's BASE childcare continues to care for the children of essential workers; and as the food ministries of the congregation and Spanaway Food Bank continue uninterrupted. Even as the world seems to have ground to a halt, the bills and obligations of the congregation continue on as before.

Unfortunately, our normal patterns for giving offering have been interrupted by the suspension of Sunday worship. The council has a few suggestions on how we might continue to make our offering to the work of the Church during these unusual times. Please consider using one of the following options for making your offering as we await returning to gather together as the Body of Christ in person:

- 1. Mail your offering to Spanaway Lutheran Church, P.O. Box 1300, Spanaway, WA 98387.
- 2. Contact your bank and have your offering automatically sent as a regular weekly or monthly check; this option involves no additional fees, needs to be done only once, and can be cancelled at any time.
- 3. Electronic giving through a Website Donate button we are developing; cost is typically \$.30 per transaction plus 1% of the amount 2.7% if a credit card is used;

In order to assist members of the congregations, in the next week or so you will receive a mailing from the church with offering envelopes and/or mailing labels along with offering designation slips. To make the best use of congregational funds, your quarterly giving statement will also be included in the mailing. In addition we will provide instruction from major financial institutions on how to set up automatic giving through your bank or savings and loan. The "Donate" button may take a week or two.
