1. The four sections of the orchestra.
STRINGS, BRASS, WOODWIND AND PERCUSSION.
2. Learn the instruments of the strings and woodwind sections.
You will be asked to identify them you could use YOUTUBE to revise their sounds.
3. **The Elements of Music.**

Pitch - The highness/lowness of a musical sound. HIGH/LOW

Tempo - The speed of the music. FAST/SLOW

Dynamics - The loudness/softness of the music. LOUD/SOFT

Texture - The number of instruments in the music. THICK/THIN

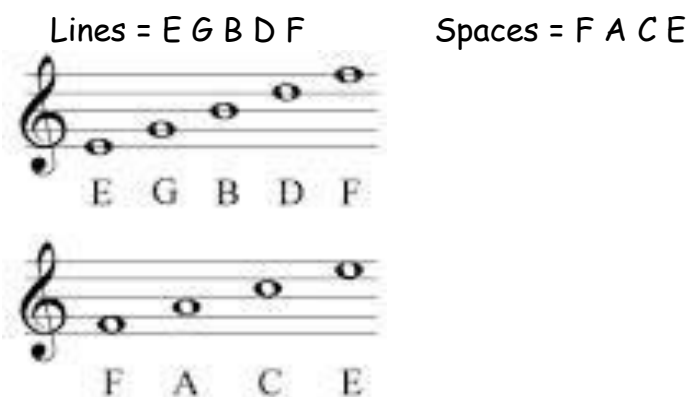
Timbre - The different sounds of the instruments.

Duration/Rhythm - The length of the notes. LONG/SHORT

Pulse - The steady beat in the music.

4. **Notes on the Treble Clef.**






Music is written on five lines called a **STAVE**.



5. Carnival of the Animals - Saint Saen.

Saint Saen was born in Paris in 1835. He became very famous as a composer. He wrote a piece of music about animals called "The Carnival of the Animals". In this piece he uses music to describe animals such as lions, tortoises, the elephant, and a piece called the Aquarium.

6. Note Values

Semibreve		Whole Note
Minim		Half Note
Crotchet		Quarter Note
Quaver		Eighth Note
Semiquavers		Sixteenth Notes

Semibreve = 4 Minim = 2 Crotchet = 1 Quaver = $\frac{1}{2}$
