- Please, no pets! Only fiber animals entered to show, or are for sale or display are permitted on grounds.
- Vendors may set up the evening before between 12:00 and 6 p.m. or in the morning of from 6 a.m to 8:30 a.m. All vehicles must be moved to the designated vendor parking area by 8:30 and vendors ready by 9 a.m. While the farm is private, no security will be provided overnight.
- Vendors must remain set up until the close of the event at 5 p.m.
- Vendors must provide their own pop-ups or tents. Space is limited to 10x10 and you are required to secure tents with stakes or weights.
- Vendors and/or exhibitors with animals must provide their own pens and animals must be secure at all times.
- All animals, whether for display, competition or sale, must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) issued within the 30 days prior to the event.
- Damage or Loss: The exhibitor and/or vendor assumes all risks of damage or loss, either to person or property, for all and every cause whatsoever, including fire, the elements, violation of the law, theft, negligence either on the part of Flock-n-Spiel and Lower Sherwood Farm, its volunteers, sponsors, employees or management or other person(s).; and it is further understood and agreed between the exhibitor and/or vendor and management that Flock-n-Spiel/Lower Sherwood Farm incurs no liability or obligation to the exhibitor/vendor.
- Any and all sales that take place during the event are between the buyer and seller only. Event coordinators, hosts, sponsors, etc. take no responsibility for any sales.
