


Demographic Information

- More than 100,000 people in North America participate in dragon boating including over 1,500 in the Portland Metro area.
- More women than men participate (nearly 2 to 1)
- Paddlers tend to be older 21% are 36 to 45; 29% are 46 to 55; and 23% are 56 to 65.
- Education 81% hold a college degree and of those 32% hold advanced degrees.
- Dragon boaters are relatively well to do with 57% individually earning between \$50,000 and \$100,000. Household income for 41% is more the \$100,000.
- Unlike many other sporting events, a Paddle for Life Dragon boat race takes about 8 hours per day to complete. This gives our sponsors a captive audience that is repeatedly exposed to their brand and message before or during this event.
- On average each participant brings 2.5 additional friends or family members who are present for most of the day. We are expecting about 1,500 people for this year's race.
- Participants in dragon boating ran ge from 13 to 90+ making it one of the most inclusive sports in the world. Nearly anyone can get in the boat and race, no experience necessary! No athletic ability required!
