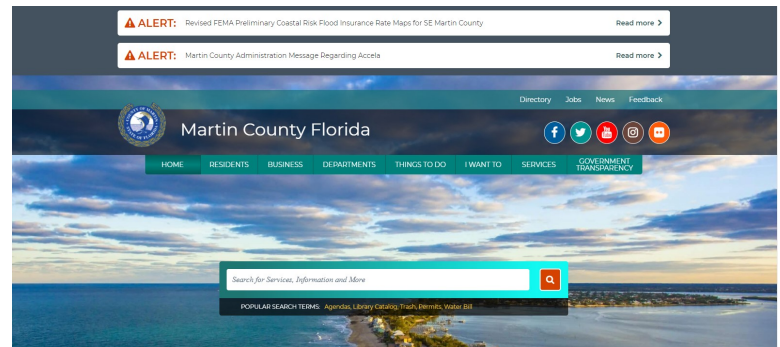
HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

One of the many things I learned in the Martin CARES course is how to stay connected during times of a crisis, such as a hurricane. This can apply to you whether you are here in Florida or elsewhere.

The Martin County website (www.martin.fl.us) is a treasure trove of information. I think you could easily spend a couple hours checking things out on the website. There was way too much for me to show in pictures or detail here. But for now, I want to focus on what to do during a hurricane.

My understanding is the regular updates will be posted on the website. Not only that, if you scroll down the homepage, you will see a link to MCTV, the local television station (channel 20 on your TV). You can also get information through there.

If you are on Facebook, there are some valuable resources there. You might search for the Martin County Board of County Commissioners page and like/join it. When you do, you will have to option to opt to receive a number of different newsletters. You can also search for the Martin County Sherriff's Office and like their page.



Both pages have information that may be of interest to you, but during a hurricane you should be able to find important information there.

They are on Twitter (twitter.com/MartinCountygov?lang=).

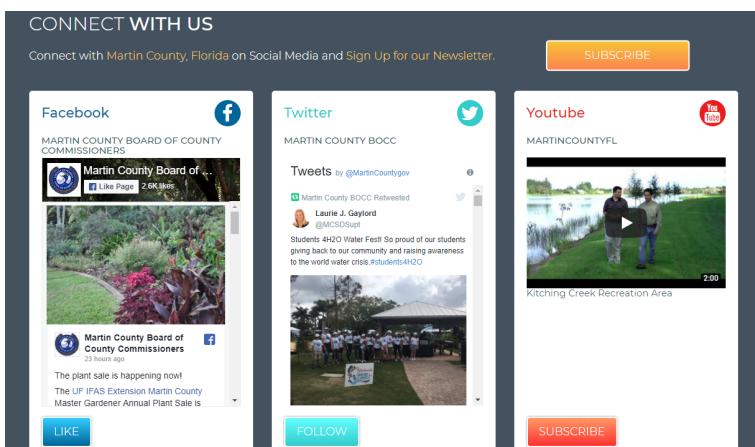
By no means did we just sit in a classroom for 5 weeks. We traveled throughout the county and saw all kinds of interesting things in action.

One day we went to engineering where there were a multitude of computer screens on the wall showing different traffic intersections throughout the county. The traffic light patterns can be changed if the need arises – in the event of an evacuation, the traffic lights will be changed accordingly.

We got to see what I will call the crisis center – the place where all the action happens during a hurricane. It was fascinating to see and have all the different aspects of it explained to us. Trust me, there is a lot going on!

From there, we went into the 911 call center and we were able to see that in action. We enjoyed a live simulation of the response to a 911 call with the paramedics rushing in to save the “dummy” who had collapsed on the floor.

BLOOD PRESSURE CLINIC

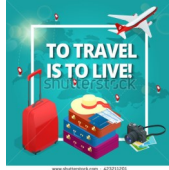
The blood pressure clinic are held on Wednesdays, from 10 to 11:30am in the clubhouse. They will finish at the end of May and resume in the fall.

ANSWERS TO INTERESTING QUESTIONS

1... WHY?

Why do men's clothes have buttons on the right while women's clothes have buttons on the left?

In card games, it was once customary to pass an item, called a buck, from player to player to indicate whose turn it was to deal. If a player did not wish to assume the responsibility of dealing, he would 'pass the buck' to the next player.

5 ... WHY?

Why do people clink their glasses before drinking a toast?

BECAUSE

It used to be common for someone to try to kill an enemy by offering him a poisoned drink. To prove to a guest that a drink was safe, it became customary for a guest to pour a small amount of his drink into the glass of the host. Both men would drink it simultaneously. When a guest trusted his host, he would only touch or clink the host's glass with his own.

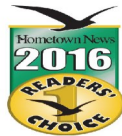
