Time Commitment: The Junior Board members will serve from August to May. There are quarterly board meetings. However, meetings may be more frequent as determined by the Board. Take an active part and attend at least 2 GO Pantry events each semester.

Application Process:

Applications accepted through August 1st. Interviews will be conducted by board members and community members through August 15th.
