Selling/Giving Away Adopted Horses violates the Adoption Agreement and violators will be prosecuted. You must also NEVER EVER move an equine to another location without prior permission and inspection from LHPR even if it is only for a short time or a short distance away.

The same procedure applies to volunteers and committee members.

When you receive the animal, it will already have its teeth done by our qualified equine dental technician, have its feet done by our master farrier. They are also vaccinated against tetanus and flu, received a de-lice treatment, vetted and are

micro chipped with a valid passport. They will also be on a strict worming programme so will be fully up to date with worming.

*Please note this is a minimum donation, you are more than welcome to give a greater donation – as all donations go directly to the running of the rescue centre. The donation is based on the ability of the equine at the time of application (unbroken, broken or strictly companion). These are non-refundable.

- Ensure that feet are trimmed or shod regularly by a Registered Farrier.
- You as the adopter is fully responsible for all costs associated with the equine including emergency veterinary bills
- Not to breed from the equine.
- Not to use the equine, or permit the equine to be used, for hunting live guarry.
- Notify the Gardaí/Police and the Organization within 24 hours should the equine become lost, stolen or missing.
- Permit an official of the Organization to visit my premises from time to time to check the well-being of the equine
- Allow the Organization to repossess the equine if, in the Organization's opinion, the terms of this agreement are not being adhered to.
- If Euthanasia is recommended by a veterinary surgeon, the Organization must be contacted before this is done, unless delay would result in unnecessary suffering for the equine. If there is a question of choice, lethal injection is preferable to humane killer.
- I agree and understand that whilst LHPR gives as much information as possible, they do not always have a complete history of the equine and cannot therefore, guarantee temperament, behaviour, or health of the equine.
- After a period of 3 months the adopter will receive the animal's original passport. Up until this three-month period, LHPR will keep the passport. Each year at an agreed time with you, this passport will be inspected to ensure its contents (in particular vaccine information) is up to date. If the vaccine information is not up to date, the passport will be revoked, and the equine may be removed from your care. In the event of the equine's death, you must also return the passport to us immediately, so we can declare the animal deceased on the national equine database.
- I agree that I have been made fully aware of all responsibilities, which I freely enter into on the signing of this agreement, for the above equine
- I confirm that I am over 18 years of age.
- Under the Animal Health and Welfare Act 2013, I have a legal responsibility for the above animal and any animal.

Please note the following also

- LHPR are not responsible for any veterinary / farrier / dentistry costs and will not reimburse you for same even in the event of the equine having to be returned to LHPR, regardless of reason.
- The donation for the above equine is non-refundable this is not negotiable
- In the event of an equine having to be returned to LHPR due to medical reasons we do request a veterinary report
- You the adopter will be responsible for transporting the equine back to LHPR in the event of such having to happen.
- NB: The Leinster Horse and Pony Rescue, has a zero-tolerance policy on breeding, if an adopter carer is found in breach of this policy, the equine will be immediately removed from the premises of the adopter and we will seek prosecution for violating our policy. We also have a zerotolerance policy on moving equines to another location without our prior permission.
