**Before you qualify to be able to rehome an equine from LHPR we kindly ask you to complete this short questionnaire. Please be open and honest with your answers.**

<u>Question</u>	<u>Answer</u>
Are you aged 18 and over and a resident of the Republic Of/Northern Ireland	
Many of our equines have come from situations of abuse, neglect and cruelty. At the time of rehoming not all are fully rehabilitated. The ones not fully rehabilitated can take a lot of time and work to come right. Are you willing and experienced enough to do this?	
Have you and all your family members fully discussed getting a new horse and have you all taken into the account the lifespan of the horse etc?	
Are you financially prepared to look after a horse? Vet bills, farrier, dentist, bedding, feed etc	
Have you all the necessary facilities for looking after a horse correctly? Shelter, paddock, Equine Premises Number and liability insurance?	
Horses can be unpredictable. Are you willing to work through any and all behavioural issues as they arise? Such issues can have many different causes - illness, discomfort (caused by injury, ill-fitting tack, etc.). Are you committed to exploring these potential causes before considering returning the horse to LHPR? <b>Returning the horse to LHPR must be seen as a very last resort.</b>
