We only accept applications of permanent and forever homes.

If you cannot accommodate the equine when you or your child transitions to a larger pony/horse , please do not apply as your application will be rejected.

Leinster Horse and Pony Rescue will process your personal data for the purposes of achieving the stated objectives of rescuing, rehabilitating and re-homing equines in need and any associated fundraising activities to provide for their care. It is our policy not to transfer your data to any other organisations*.

LHPR uses a secure online system designed specially, for animal rescue groups and animal control agencies. This online system stores all its information on servers that are hosted in an ISO 27001 certified data centre in London to comply with GDPR requirements. Information is held for the duration of the adoption, it is then destroyed.

* From time to time Leinster Horse and Pony Rescue may disclose information to third parties such as the Department of Agriculture Food and Marine, An Garda Síochána and Local Government (City and county councils). This will only be done upon them submitting a request to us.
