## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**MINIMUM ORDER:** Our usual initial minimum booking order is \$2500.00.

**SHIPDATES:** Bareroot and Packaged Bareroot shipping begins 12/1/17, except for shade trees, specialty fruits & other varieties specifically keyed S, they ship after 1/2/18. Container and Field Grown Stock ships in Fall and Spring.

**FREIGHT:** Freight will be charged from Portland, Oregon, and billed separately from plant material invoicing. Freight charges will be a percentage of the invoice based upon the dollar volume and distance from Portland, Oregon. Federal ICC regulations dictate payment of freight charges within Seven (7) days of invoicing. Our truck broker provides a prepaid freight service on the assumption that ICC Regulations will be observed. All shipments travel at the risk and cost of the purchaser. Our responsibility ceases upon delivery to the carrier.

**DISCOUNTS:** Inquire about Pacific Groves Inc. **Pre-Pay discounts**, our **volume discount** rates, and our **full truck-load discount**.

**TERMS:** Our regular terms are 2%, 10 days or NET 30 days from date of invoice to all customers with an established credit record for prompt payment.

**PRICES:** Prices are listed for the trade and cancel all previous prices offered by Pacific Groves Inc.. Prices are subject to change without notice.

**CANCELLATIONS:** All cancellations must be received in writing no later than 15 days prior to shipping or there shall be a 10% restocking charge.

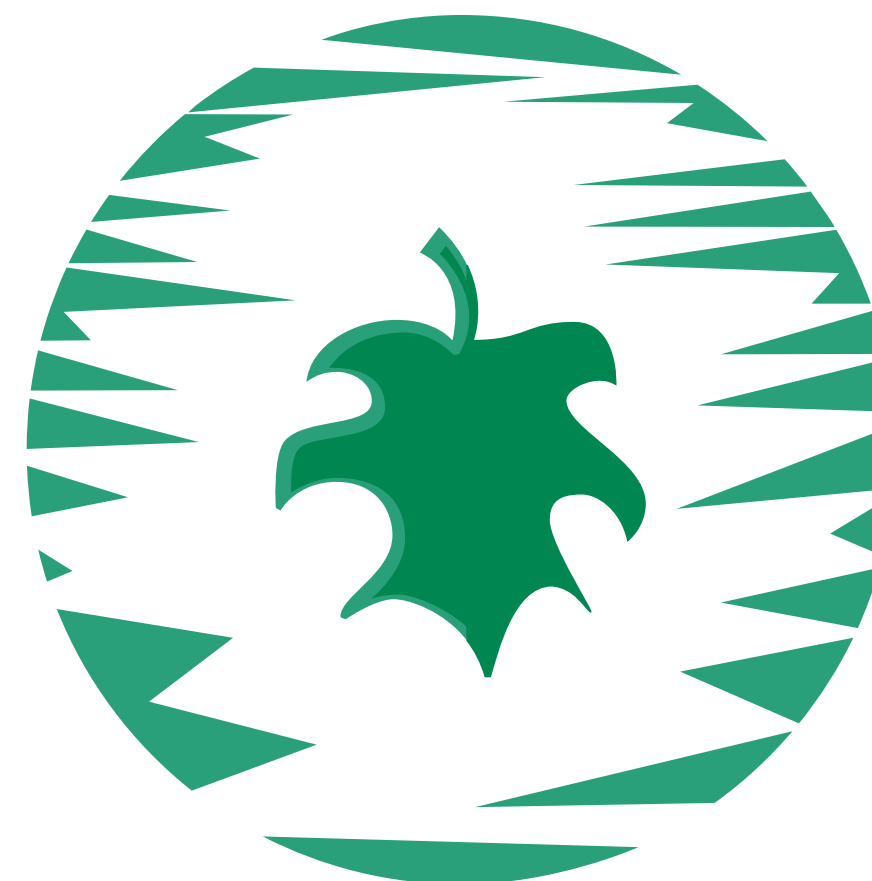

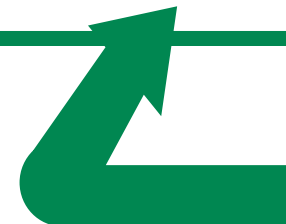
