As you know, Robertson County has a very rich history, going back for over a century, in Whiskey (Green Brier Distillery) and Dark Fired Tobacco. Tobacco has been a commercial product since around 1820. Springfield TN has been acknowledged as the Dark-Fired Tobacco Capital of the World. From 1904 to 1909 our local area and families saw many changes in the Tobacco Industry. (The Black Patch Tobacco War period). Today, Tobacco is still the #2 source of Revenue for this area.
