

MINUTES
3/13/17

The Town of Melrose held their monthly meeting Monday evening, March 13, 2017 at 6pm at the Melrose Village Hall. Those present were Bill Zielsdorf, Kim Torres, Shane Zeman, John Arneson, Paul Hangartner, Bill Freise, Al Spors and Mike Kunes.

Zielsdorf called the meeting to order. Hangartner moved to approve the Agenda, Arneson seconded.

The minutes were read by the clerk. Motion by Hangartner, seconded by Arneson to approve them as read.

The Treasurer gave his report. The February ending balance was \$66,175.62. Hangartner moved to accept the report as given, Arneson seconded.

Motion made to approve and pay bills.

Mike Kunes was in attendance to request permission to haul corn while the road band is still on. He also discussed the current Elementary bldg. in the Village and what will happen to it once the new school is built. His opinion is for the Town to possibly work together with the Village to keep the bldg. existing and salvageable for board room space. Lastly he asked that the Town look at the culvert below Garbers farm and requested a few loads of gravel.

The tractor is now in Peewaukee, WI having the hydraulics worked on. Zielsdorf will keep the Board posted with any further progress.

Torres discussed the Chris Meier land purchase. She contacted Terry Schmidt and received information regarding the regulations from the DNR. The Board agreed that if Meier is interested in the information we have gathered that he needs to attend a meeting for further discussion.

The Board discussed moving the next Town Board meeting to Tues. April 18th from the original date of April 10th. This meeting will follow the Annual Meeting.

Zielsdorf discussed the David Lloyd residence and notified the Board that he has contacted Terry Schmidt in Zoning at the County level to take care of any issues with him.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 6:45pm.
