The Town of Melrose held their monthly meeting Monday evening, March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 6pm at the Melrose Village Hall. Those present were Bill Zielsdorf, Kim Torres, Shane Zeman, Paul Hangartner, Bill Freise, and Al Spors.

Motion made by Freise, seconded by Hangartner to make a \$30,000 tractor payment

Clerk Torres made a note that next month's meeting will be moved to the following Tuesday (of next month) for the Annual Meeting. The Annual Meeting will be at 6pm at the Melrose Town Hall on Tuesday, April 17<sup>th</sup> with the regular Board Meeting following the Annual Meeting.

Nordstrom Construction (Melrose) - \$249,960.00 Bautch Construction (Independence) - \$215,580.00 Lynn Builders (Sparta) - \$262,363.00 Olympic Builders (Holmen) - \$249,945.00 T2 Construction (Tomah) - \$259,403.54 Simmons Construction (Holmen) - \$244,900.00 Brickl Bros. (West Salem) - \$235,154.00

The Town chose to go with the lowest bid. Motion was made by Hangartner to accept Bautch Construction as the final bid, seconded by Freise. The Board approved up to \$225,000.00 from Black River Country Bank. All were in favor, motion carried. The new Town Shop construction will begin April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
