## MINUTES 1/14/19

The Town of Melrose held their monthly meeting following the 2019 Caucus on Monday evening, January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 6pm at the Melrose Town Hall. Those present were Bill Zielsdorf, Kim Torres, Shane Zeman, Bill Freise, Paul Hangartner & Al Spors.
