

Rules for Riding

Here are some general rules to make your experience safer and more enjoyable.

- Always wear your helmet.
- No open toe shoes or flip flops
- Always wear eye protection
- **Do not ride in bicycle paths or sidewalks**
- I will hear about it if you do and you will be charged your full deposit and the ticket will be mailed to you as well (that's \$500 dollars you don't wanna spend)
- Do not let anyone else ride the scooter, you are responsible for whatever may happen to it, any damage will be taken out of your deposit.
- Some stop lights will not cycle because you are too small. Try to let a car by or stop next to the curb and push the pedestrian button.
- These scooters are not made for off road riding remain on paved surfaces.
- Always lock your scooter (turn handlebars all the way to the left and remove key) Use provided lock.
- Let traffic pass you.
- Obey traffic laws.
- Avoid steep hills remember these are only 50cc scoots
- Use your turn signals and hand signals.
- Do not follow too close
- Have fun.
