

Code of Discipline for Indoor Season

The hall is booked from **1pm to 4pm on Sundays**.

Please wear soft soled shoes in the hall. **No outdoor shoes are to be worn.**

On arrival, please **listen for three whistles before entering the hall.**

Set up your bow and then **ask to join a target.** This is simple politeness and normal etiquette for archery. It will also help you to get to know people – remember to introduce yourself if you don't know someone's name.

Audible signals (whistles) will be given to indicate when it is safe to shoot or collect.

Please try to have only **4 archers per target.**

Code of Discipline for Outdoor Season

On arrival you may park at the container. If you are the first to arrive, **please register** at the Range Control office.

All **equipment** is held in the container at the north end of the Range.

When setting up bosses get someone to help you as they can be heavy.

The **minimum distance** for outdoor shooting **should be 25m** - there's usually a tape measure along the field for distances.

Audible signals (whistles) will be given to indicate when it is safe to shoot or collect.

Please try to have only **4 archers per target.** If there is no space on a target at the distance you want to shoot please put out another boss from the storage container. If you need any help getting equipment feel free to ask one of the more experienced archers. They will be more than happy to help.

When archers start to leave, please **fill up spaces on other targets** (max 4 archers). If possible, help to **put away an empty target** before you leave.

To aid with putting equipment away at the end of the night, **please do not take your equipment off the field until all empty targets are away.**

If someone loses an arrow on your target **help them find it - do not start walking back** until that arrow is found. If you are having trouble finding the arrow call more people over. If you are on the shooting line and realise a target is having trouble finding a lost arrow walk back up the field and offer to help.

Please **refrain from smoking** near the waiting or shooting line.

Headphones and headsets should not be worn on the shooting line.
