

Anti-wrinkle injections

One of the most effective ways to look younger and enhance your appearance is to smooth and soften away the tell-tale signs of aging; the dreaded wrinkles. This is done using gentle “wrinkle relaxing injections” or dermal fillers to the affected area.

Many of us are now choosing to give nature a helping hand by using non-surgical facial aesthetic treatments such as using “wrinkle relaxing injections” of Botulinum Toxin (Botox®/Bocouture/Azzalure®) or dermal fillers (e.g. Juvederm/Juvederm ultra) for a fresher but natural look.

Why choose facial aesthetics treatments with a dentist?

As clinicians, dentists are highly knowledgeable about facial anatomy, they are skilled in using their hands for meticulous work using fine instruments and injecting.

Your treatment will be carried out in a clean, clinical environment using safe equipment and well researched material.



Why Botulinum Toxin?

Botulinum Toxin is a purified protein which is injected into specific muscles in the face to temporarily relax them, softening facial expressions and helping to re-verse signs of aging.

How long does the procedure take?

Injections for wrinkle reduction take approximately 15-30 minutes.

When will I see results?

It takes an average of 2-3 days to start working, although it may take a little longer for the full effects to be seen. The speed of the action will depend on the strength of your facial muscles and your individual response to the injection.

How long will the results last?

The effects of the injection last between 4-6 months, although it will vary from patient to patient. Because Botulinum Toxin is a safe material, it can be repeated as necessary. As soon as you notice your facial wrinkles begin to relax and retake their old shape, you can schedule your next retreatment.

Does it hurt?

It is a simple and safe procedure, using a tiny micro-needle and a very small amount of the Botulinum Toxin is used. The pain associated with the injection is minimal, there maybe be some mild discomfort, but generally it is a painless procedure.



Why Dermal fillers?

Dermal fillers are substances/gels injected beneath the skins surface to smooth wrinkles and add volume.

Dermal fillers mimic skin’s own natural “plumper” hyaluronic acid: a substance which normally deteriorates with age, resulting in lines and wrinkles. With fine, precise application of the injection, lines and wrinkles appear “filled”, smoothed and dramatically reduced.

How long does the procedure take?

Injections for Dermal fillers take approximately 20-40 minutes.

When will I see the results?

Dermal filler effects can be seen immediately, although the final results will become clear once any swelling has gone down.

How long will the results last?

The results will usually last 6-9 months, but will vary from patient to patient.

Does it hurt?

You may experience minor discomfort during the injection of fillers. Topical anesthetics can be applied to the skin before the procedure to help minimize any discomfort. We can also use Juvederm Ultra, which contains local anesthetic.



What will happen at my consultation?

How much will it cost?

The Initial consultation fee is £15.00, but this will be deducted from any treatment costs., if you proceed.


