

In our initiative to bridge the gap we have welcomed back several of our churches. We have reached out to many others that are very interested in joining this great Association.


We are very excited about are Bethany District choir and we are looking forward to an upcoming concert from them.


We are excited about the continued success of all of our auxiliaries and the great work that they have been doing we are looking for their help as we will be hosting the state this year.

Riding in the Second Chariot



Riding in the Second Chariot is an arm of the Parent Body. It consists of Associate Ministers and Evangelists in the churches. One thing that is stressed is that someone who is riding in the Second Chariot is not riding in the first chariot. That position is reserved for the Pastor.

There are three things that are required of someone riding in the Second Chariot. The first point is, we are servants. We serve God by serving others.

Jesus himself said that he came not to be served but to serve. (Matthew 20:28) We must seek to serve the needs of the Pastor and the congregation in whatever assignment we are given.

Secondly, we are soldiers. Anyone entering the armed forces must first go through a basic training period. 2 Timothy 2:15 says. "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." The Bethany School of Biblical Studies is an excellent vehicle for training so that we can effectively exercise the gift God has placed in us.

Each year during the Annual Session we have a Preach-A-Thon. It is a service that allots each participant 15 minutes to preach the Word of God. It is form of training that causes the preacher to focus on the time and contents of his or her message in a short period of time.

Thirdly, we are to be steadfast. 1 Corinthians 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord." Permanent Council's Ministry Description

The Permanent Council is composed of ordained ministers of the Association who have the power to pass on matters pertaining to the business of the council. The Officers of the Council are President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, who will perform the customary duties of each office.

The Council in conjunction with The Bethany Baptist Association School of Biblical Studies (BBSBS) help educate and prepare candidates for ordination. In conjunction with the applicants' churches, the council, school and ordained pastors of Bethany examine each student and ensure each student is prepared for pastoring. The council also participates in each candidate's ordination celebration.

Upon a request, preferably written, from a pastor or church leaders, the Permanent Council will assist any Bethany Baptist Association churches with disputes, recognitions, and investigations of churches or individuals making applications for membership which are within the purview of the council.

The Council is available, upon request, to assist any vacant Bethany church by supplying qualified preachers for Sunday services and pastoral candidates. The Council will also provide advise and assistance with succession planning to any Bethany church seeking to call a Pastor. The Council will provide all vacant churches with a list of Bethany trained and ordained preachers for worship services and applicants to be considered for the pastorate.

If a Licentiate (unordained minister) is called to Pastor an association church or called as an assistant to the Pastor of a church, or as a missionary under some authorized board or organization; and a request is made by the church or Pastor, the Licentiate shall be deemed eligible to be considered for ordination and the Council will assist said church with the Pastor-Elect's ordination.

Any church that calls a pastor whose ordination is questionable, the church should contact the Permanent Council if it desires assistance in credential verification. All candidates seeking to pastor should be ordained by a credible or accredited Baptist Association. In this regard, if any church calls a minister to pastor that is not ordained, said church should request assistance by the Bethany Baptist Association in the ordination process of their Pastor.

BETHANY BAPTIST ASSOCIATION SCHOOL OF BIBLICAL STUDIES

The Bethany Baptist School of Biblical Studies is offering a new and exciting curriculum for the ministerial staff and lay leaders. These courses are designed to help transition your church leadership base to understanding the challenges of stability in the 21st Century. The cultural shifts in our society make it imperative that we develop new methods and, at the same time, solidify biblical doctrine. This new generation is not going to be reached by our present traditions and practices, so we must have informed and trained leaders working in our churches.

The curriculum track will be governed by the following standards: (1) All courses require eight (8) classroom hours (2 each week) for certification; (2) There will be weekly "in-class exercises" but NO FINAL for these courses; (3) Additional reading may be assigned by each **Teach-ing Facilitator**; (4) Course cost is \$100 per course.
