SHOW RULES (Please read carefully):

- ❖ Clean, neat show attire is required — hat or helmet, and boots with a heel are mandatory
- ❖ Tack is to be in good and safe working condition
- ❖ Youth (defined as any person **18 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2017**) are not allowed to handle stallions
- ❖ Youth are required to wear an approved helmet in all riding classes
- ❖ Leadline is open to all youth, however they cannot enter any other riding classes
- ❖ The same horse/rider combination entering walk/trot classes may not enter any class requiring a canter/lope (and vice versa – you cannot move down to walk/trot after going in a canter class)
- ❖ NO martingales, draw reins or other training devices will be allowed in classes
- ❖ Horses aged 6 and older must be shown in a curb bit with a chin strap, one-handed in all Western classes. The chin strap must be at least one-half inch in width and lay flat against the jaw of the horse. The exception to the age rule is in the Green Horse class, where green horses may be ridden in a snaffle bit regardless of age.
- ❖ There may be patterns for all equitation, showmanship and horsemanship classes. Patterns will be available and posted for western riding and reining classes.
- ❖ There will be a strict 2-minute gate policy unless extra time is requested prior to show
- ❖ Pre-entries are due **Wednesday, July 5th, 2017**. Any late entries will be assessed a **\$10 late fee**. Please note that payment is due on the day of show. There is no deposit required.
- ❖ Stakes classes are open to all riders in Youth, Senior and Open. Each class has a \$20 entry fee and can be entered on the day of the show. Payouts for 1st through 3rd are determined by number of entries. 100% payback, must have at least 3 entries to run the class.
- ❖ All entries can be sent to Tammy Paquette: 268 Nicholetts Road, Murillo, ON POT2G0 or email royaldenverfarms@tbaytel.net; an online entry form may also be provided.
- ❖ NSF cheques will be assessed a \$25.00 fee
- ❖ Any form of abuse, physical or verbal, to officials or other contestants will result in disqualification for the day at the discretion of the Show Committee
- ❖ The judge has the sole authority to excuse any horse from the class, due to lameness or otherwise inhumane appearance, at any time while being judged. Please note that the judge's decision is final, and that any fees paid will not be reimbursed.
- ❖ An LLHA membership is not mandatory to show, however it **is** required in order to qualify for any year-end awards.
- ❖ Points will be calculated on the basis of how many entries are in the class, up to 6 horses in the class, for example:
 - 1 horse in class = 1 point for 1st
 - 3 horses in class = 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 1 point for 3rd
 - 8 horses in class = 6 points for 1st (judge will only place to 6th)
- ❖ Stalls are \$15 to rent for the day and **MUST BE BOOKED BY THE PRE-ENTRY DATE** due to biohazard preparation. There will be no exceptions. No deposit required.
