

AS WE GATHER: The Christian Church Calendar begins a new year in the season called Advent. "Advent" means "coming" and is the name of a 4 week season of the Church Year which focuses on the coming of Jesus. He came as a 1) baby to be our Savior; He comes to us 2) now in Word and the Sacraments; and He will come again 3) on the Last Day. Advent is a season of preparation and repentance ... a time to get ready ... join us each Sunday and Wednesday during Advent and make the most important preparations for Christmas possible by getting the right Spirit of the Birthday of our King!

The Church Year begins in Advent by telling the story of our Lord's earthly ministry. As we prepare to celebrate His first coming at Christmas in the Means of Grace, we also look to the final resurrection when He will come again on the Last Day. Advent is a time of anticipation and expectation. We do our best to hold off on Christmas celebrations and wait until the close of Advent to even sing Christmas Hymns. Our postures can help us visualize such waiting. Tonight we focus on The Lord of Advent who calls his people to be watchful during this season. God's Word encourages in us an expectant posture toward the coming of our Lord.
