

# Preterism 201

An Additional 100 Scriptures Which Predict AD 70 Fulfillment

- 1) **Matt. 5:18:** For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.
- 2) **Matt. 8:12:** But the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into outer darkness....
- 3) **Matt. 10:15:** Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!
- 4) **Matt. 10:22:** And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end will be saved.
- 5) **Matt. 11:22,24:** But I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the day of judgment than for you. But I say to you that it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment than for you. (See **Matt. 12:36, Mark 6:11**)
- 6) **Matt. 12:41-45:**....will rise up with this wicked generation and condemn it.
- 7) **Matt. 13: 30:** Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn."
- 8) **Matt. 13: 39-41, 49:** The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels. Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age. The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness. So will it be at the end of the age.
- 9) **Matt. 19:27-30:** Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration, when the Son of man sits on the throne of his glory, you who have followed Me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. (cf. **Mark 10:28-31**)
- 10) **Matt. 21:21:**...you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, "Be removed and be cast into the sea", it will be done.
- 11) **Matt. 22:7:** But when the king heard about it, he was furious. And he sent out his armies, destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city.
- 12) **Matt. 24:1-3:** Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down." Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?" (cf. **Mark 13:2-4; Luke 21:6-7**)
- 13) **Matt. 24:30:** And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven; and then shall all the tribes of the land lament, and they shall see the Son of man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- 14) **Matt. 25:31:** When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory. (cf. **Matt. 19:28; Mark 8:38**)
- 15) **Matt. 27:25:** And all the people answered and said, "His blood be on us and on our children."
- 16) **Mark 13: 24-31:** But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars of heaven will fall, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. And then He will send His angels, and gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest part of earth to the farthest part of heaven. Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender, and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see these things happening, know that it is near—at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. (cf. **Matt. 24:29-35; Luke 21:27-36**)
- 17) **Luke 10:18:** And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven".
- 18) **Luke 1:32:** He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.
- 19) **Luke 13:3-5:**...unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.
- 20) **Luke 13:35:** See! Your house is left to you desolate....(cf. **Matt 23:38**)
- 21) **Luke 14:14:**...for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just.
- 22) **Luke 17:24-37:** For as the lightning that flashes out of one part under heaven shines to the other part under heaven, so also the Son of Man will be in His day. And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all. Even so will it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed....the one will be taken and the other left. And they answered and said to Him, "Where, Lord?" So He said to them, "Wherever the body is, there the eagles will be gathered together." (cf. **Matt. 24:27,36-42**)
- 23) **Luke 18:8:** tell you that He will avenge them (His own elect) speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
- 24) **Luke 19:43-44:** For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation.

- 25) **Luke 21:20**: But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near.
- 26) **Luke 22:18**:...for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes.
- 27) **John 4:21**: Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father."
- 28) **John 5:28-29**: Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.
- 29) **John 6:39-40, 44, 54**:...but should raise it up at the last day....and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 30) **John 14:3,28**: And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. You have heard Me say to you, I am going away and coming back to you....
- 31) **Acts 2:40**: And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation."
- 32) **Acts 1:11**: This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.
- 33) **Acts 3:19-21**: Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before, whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began.
- 34) **Acts 6:14**: for we have heard him say that this Jesus of Nazareth will destroy this place and change the customs which Moses delivered to us.
- 35) **Acts 14:22**:...we must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God.
- 36) **Romans 2:5**: But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God.
- 37) **Romans 8:11**: But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.
- 38) **Romans 8:23, 25**:....we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body....we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.
- 39) **Romans 11:25-26**:...that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. And so all Israel will be saved.....
- 40) **I Cor. 1:7-8**:...so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will also confirm you to the end, that you may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 41) **I Cor. 2:6**:...nor the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing.
- 42) **I Cor. 4:5**: Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God.
- 43) **1 Cor. 5:5**:...that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- 44) **I Cor. 6:14**: And God both raised up the Lord and will also raise us up by His power.
- 45) **I Cor. 11:26**: For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death til He comes.
- 46) **I Cor. 13:8-10,12**: Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away....but then face to face....
- 47) **I Cor. 15:22,23,24,26,49,53,54**:...in Christ all shall be made alive. But each one in his own order; Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom of God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power....The last enemy that will be destroyed is death....we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.....for when this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality.....
- 48) **II Cor. 1:10**:...and does deliver us; in whom we trust that He will still deliver us...
- 49) **II Cor. 3:11**: For if what is passing away was glorious, what remains is much more glorious.
- 50) **II Cor. 4:14**: Knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with Jesus, and will present us with you.
- 51) **II Cor. 5:1-5**:...earnestly desiring to be clothed with our habitation which is from heaven....not because we want to be unclothed, but further clothed, that mortality may be swallowed up by life.
- 52) **II Cor. 11:2**: For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. (cf. **Eph. 5:27, Col. 1:22, 28, Jude 1:24**)
- 53) **Galatians 1:4**:...that He might deliver us from this present evil age.....
- 54) **Ephesians 1:10**: that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.
- 55) **Ephesians 4:30**: And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
- 56) **Philippians 1:6**:...that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.
- 57) **Philippians 1:10; 2:16**:...til the day of Christ....in the day of Christ. (cf. **II Cor. 1:14**)
- 58) **Philippians 3: 20-21**: For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body, that it may be conformed to His glorious body....
- 59) **Colossians 3: 4**: When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

- 60) **Colossians 3:6:** Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience
- 61) **I Thess. 1:10:**....Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.
- 62) **I Thess. 2:16:**...so as always to fill up the measure of their sins; but wrath has come upon them to the uttermost.
- 63) **I Thess. 2:19:** Is it not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming?
- 64) **I Thess. 3:13:**....at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.
- 65) **I Thess. 4:14:**...even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.
- 66) **I Thess. 5:2:** For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so come as a thief in the night.
- 67) **II Thess. 2:1:** Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together with Him...
- 68) **II Timothy 4:8:** Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.
- 69) **Titus 2:13** looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.
- 70) **Hebrews 3:14; 6:11:**....steadfast to the end....until the end
- 71) **Hebrews 9:28:** To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.
- 72) **Hebrews 12:27-28:** Now this, "Yet once more," indicates the removal of those things that are being shaken, as of things that are made, that the things which cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken.....
- 73) **James 5:9:** Behold, the Judge is standing at the door!
- 74) **I Peter 1:7,13:** that the genuineness of your faith...may be found...at the revelation of Jesus Christ...the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- 75) **I Peter 4:13:**...that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.
- 76) **I Peter 5:4:** And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive a crown of glory that does not fade away.
- 77) **II Peter 1:16:**...when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ...
- 78) **II Peter 3:7:** But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.
- 79) **I John 2:28:**...that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming.
- 80) **I John 3:2:** Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.
- 81) **I John 4:17:** Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness I the day of judgment...
- 82) **II John 1:8:**...that we do not lose those things we worked for, but that we may receive a full reward.
- 83) **Jude 1:6:**...He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment of the great day...
- 84) **Jude 1:21:**...looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
- 85) **Rev. 1:7:** Behold, he comes with the clouds, and every eye shall see him, and they which have pierced him, and all the tribes of the land shall wail because of him. Yea. Amen. (cf. **Matt. 24:30**)
- 86) **Rev. 2:10:** Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation then days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.
- 87) **Rev. 1:19; 4:1:** Write the things which you have seen, the things which are, and the things which will take place after this....Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this.
- 88) **Rev. 2:5,16; 3:3:**...repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly...Repent, or else I will come to you quickly...hold fast and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you. (cf. **I Thess. 5:2; II Peter 3:10**)
- 89) **Rev. 2:26; 3:12:** And he who overcomes, and keeps my works until the end, to him I will give power over the nations...He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God....the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven....
- 90) **Rev. 6:10-17:** How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?....and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed....there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood. And the stars of heaven fell to the earth....and every mountain and island was moved out of its place....For the great day of His wrath has come....(cf. **Matt. 24:29**)
- 91) **Rev. 7:9-17:**...a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes....These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation....Therefore they are before the throne of God....They shall neither hunger or thirst anymore....And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.
- 92) **Rev. 8:13; 9:12; 11:14:** Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound! One woe is past. Behold, still two more woes are coming after these things. The second woe is past. Behold, the third woe is coming quickly.
- 93) **Rev. 11:2, 15-18:** And they (the Gentiles) will tread the holy city underfoot for forty-two months. ...The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever....Because you (God) have taken your great power and reigned...your wrath has come....Then the temple of God was opened in heaven....
- 94) **Rev. 12:7-17:** And war broke out in heaven....the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old....Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come....For the devil has come down to

you having great wrath, because that he has as short time....Now when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child...and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring.

- 95) **Rev. 14: 1-20:** They (the 144,000) sang a new song before the throne.....these were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits to God and to the Lamb.....for the hour of His judgment has come....Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication....Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat One like the son of Man, having on his head a golden crown, and in His hand, a sharp sickle....Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe. So He who sat on the cloud thrust His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped....the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.
- 96) **Rev. 16:1:**...Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth.
- 97) **Rev. 18:8,10,17,19:** Therefore her plagues will come in one day- death and mourning and famine. And she will be utterly burned with fire....For in one hour your judgment has come....For in one hour such great riches came to nothing....for in one hour she is made desolate.
- 98) **Rev. 19:2,7,17:**...He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants she by her....for the marriage of the lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready...Come and gather together for the supper of the great God...
- 99) **Rev. 20:1-15:** He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more til the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while....And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years...But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection....The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.
- 100) **Rev. 21: 2, 5, 10:** Then I, John, saw the holy city, the New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband....Behold, I make all things new.....and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God....
