NEW MEMBER AGREEMENT GRANBY TENNIS CLUB

I agree as a new member applicant that I have reviewed the Granby Tennis Club Rules and Bylaws. I understand that this is a participatory club and that I will be responsible for helping maintain the physical beauty and general health of the Club through the following:

1) **Spring/Fall Cleanups**. Each adult member (including associate members) will be required to participate in the cleanup day held each spring and each fall. A schedule will be posted in a spring issue of the Racquet Chatter. These events are a great way to meet other members and to experience the camaraderie of the Club. A \$ 40 fine per cleanup day will be assessed on members who do not participate, unless they are Senior Social Members or over the age of 70.

2) **House or Grounds Duty.** Each family (including associate members) will be required to perform house or grounds cleaning duty one time each year. A schedule will be posted in a spring issue of the Racquet Chatter and duties will be clearly listed. Members can pay an additional \$ 25 with their annual dues for the club to arrange for a cleaning 'sub', or they can hire their own qualified 'sub' from the list in the Racquet Chatter. A \$ 40 fine will be assessed on members who miss their cleaning date posted in the Racquet Chatter. This duty is waived for the Tennis Club board, social event chairs, Senior Social members and anyone over the age of 70.

3) **Social Committees**. Members may be asked to serve on a social committee. Chairing a social event entails assembling and managing a party committee to plan and host the event. This is a fun way to get to know other members off the court. A list of the season's events will run in the Racquet Chatter.
