How EWYL Works

When program participants complete a lesson, they earn "dollars" that they can spend on any material items in our Mom's Closet. These items include diapers, wipes, baby clothes, bottles, toys, cribs, and much more. In 2017, we had 130 EWYL appointments and 15 clients enrolled. Most "dollars" are spent on diapers and wipes, which are normally very expensive at commercial stores (see breakdown below). However, by attending the free EWYL classes, our moms and dads saved approximately \$1,885.83 on these essential items last year.

Savings Breakdown

General commercial costs of common items our clients need:

- Diapers \$45 for 162 count
- Wipes \$15 for 624 count
- Bus passes \$30 per month
- Gas cards \$15 per month

When our clients spend their EWYL "dollars" to purchase these items from us instead of buying them from commercial stores, it translates to \$823.33 saved on diapers, \$307.50 saved on wipes, \$700 saved on bus passes, and \$75 saved on gas cards.

Earn While You Learn (EWYL) is a program that pregnancy-resource centers across the nation use to help their clients. The program provides valuable information and teaches practical skills to pregnant single women or couples, and it also provides them with practical, emotional, and spiritual support. Through the EWYL classes, we empower our moms and dads to start adopting good lifestyle habits, and we also give them valuable information on relationships, fetal development, labor, bonding, developmental milestones, and healthy child-discipline practices.

EWYL allows our volunteers and clients to develop

trusting relationships with each other so that our moms and dads feel safe and comfortable when asking for advice or when sharing their concerns. We always say that women choose abortion because they lack supportive relationships. Through EWYL and our other programs, we strive to provide our clients with good relationships that they can count on to help them through some of the most challenging transitional times in their lives.
